If you are returning, sign up for a faction in the Character Creator ([link](#)).

- If you feel the need to change it in the future, you can - take it with the weight of changing a job in real life.
- If you are not signed up, you will not get paid out, though you will still get random loot.
- Larger factions may not be able to take non-members on their missions.

New players are encouraged to find their faction fit In-Game.

- You will be allowed on faction missions without counting towards limit. Just let faction leaders know you are new.
- If you do have a faction you are set on, you may sign up in the Character Creator.

**On-site opens at 5pm.**

Check-In opens around 7pm, in the Tavern.

Players will need to sign the yearly waiver. You can print in advance ([link](#)), or sign at Check-in.

Please bring a reusable drink container.

- There will be water available via dispenser jugs or water bottles. Even pouring the water bottle into a reusable container significantly reduces half drank bottles, preventing waste and clutter.
